Roller Shutter Price Comparison Australia

People searching for the best roller shutter price are often shown a mix of supply-only kit prices, small-window promotional prices and fully installed quotes. Those numbers are not directly comparable. This page is for comparing complete installer quotes and finding a fair local price. QUICK ANSWER

A useful roller shutter price comparison starts with the **installed price for the same window and the same specification**. Across Australia, a small manual shutter typically starts around **\$400-\$800 installed**, while a standard electric shutter is commonly **\$1,000-\$1,550 installed**. Large windows, sliding doors, solar motors and difficult access cost more.

The cheapest headline price is not automatically the best price. Compare written quotes line-by-line for slat type, motor brand, electrical work, GST, installation, warranty and any access charges before choosing an installer.

Bottom line: Compare at least three like-for-like written quotes. A low quote with missing electrical work or a weaker motor can cost more later.

Typical price ranges

Indicative supplied-and-installed pricing across Australia in 2026. Final pricing depends on installer assessment.

Small manual window	\$400 - \$800	typically up to 900 x 1200 mm, supplied and installed
Standard manual window	\$600 - \$1,000	typically around 1500 x 1500 mm, supplied and installed
Standard electric window	\$1,000 - \$1,550	hard-wired motor, supplied and installed
Large window	\$1,450 - \$2,100	typically around 2100 x 1800 mm
Sliding door shutter	\$1,800 - \$2,750+	motorised large opening

What changes the price

Window size

Width and height affect the amount of aluminium, the guide rails and the motor size. Compare the dimensions written on each quote.

Manual vs electric

Electric shutters usually cost more because of the motor, controls and electrical work. Ask whether wiring and certification are included.

Slat profile

Foam-filled aluminium, single-skin aluminium and heavier security profiles do not offer the same performance. A cheaper quote may specify a lighter product.

Motor and controls

Hard-wired switches, remotes, solar motors, battery backups and smart-home controls change the total. Ask for the motor brand and model in writing.

Access and location

Upper-storey windows, scaffolding, regional travel and difficult access can add labour. Confirm any access charges before comparing totals.

Number of windows

Whole-home jobs can reduce the price per window because measurement, travel and installation time are spread across the order.

Electrical work	Wiring, switch, certificate and electrician fees	Missing electrical work can become an extra charge
Installation	Supply-only or supplied and installed	Online kit prices often exclude labour
Warranty	Product, motor and installation warranty	The cheapest quote may provide less cover

How to find the best roller shutter price

Compare itemised written offers for the same openings. Ask each supplier to list dimensions, operation type, slat profile, motor brand, installation, electrical work, GST and warranty. Once the inclusions match, compare the final payable totals. The lowest complete offer may be the best price; the lowest incomplete offer may not be.

Search terms that lead to misleading comparisons

Be careful when comparing a "cheap roller shutter", "roller shutters from \$299" or "DIY roller shutter price" against a supplied-and-installed quote. These searches can surface useful options, but the advertised number may exclude installation, electrical work, delivery, custom sizing or GST. Use the final installed total for a fair comparison.

When the cheapest quote is not the best quote

A very low price deserves a closer look when the quote does not name the motor, provides only a short warranty, excludes electrical certification or uses a lower-spec slat. A good comparison protects you from both overpaying and accepting a cheap quote that does not cover the same job.

How these price ranges are prepared

These are indicative editorial ranges for Australian residential roller shutters, not fixed offers. They are compiled from the pricing rules used by our quote estimator, installer quote research and publicly available Australian pricing guides. We compare supplied-and-installed prices wherever possible and review the ranges as market pricing changes. Your final price still depends on the

measured openings, product specification, suburb and site access.

Checklist before you accept a quote

☐ **Collect three written quotes**

A single quote cannot show whether the price is competitive.

☐ **Match every window**

Check the dimensions and number of openings line-by-line.

☐ **Confirm all inclusions**

Installation, electrical work, GST and access charges should be explicit.

☐ **Compare warranty and product spec**

The best price is a fair total for the same level of product and cover.

Frequently asked questions

How much do roller shutters cost in Australia?

Residential roller shutters typically range from around \$400-\$800 installed for a small manual window to \$1,000-\$1,550 for a standard electric window. Large windows, sliding doors and access requirements can increase the price.

How do I compare roller shutter quotes?

Compare the same window dimensions, operation type, slat profile, motor brand, electrical work, installation, GST, access charges and warranty. Use the final installed total, not a promotional starting price.

How many roller shutter quotes should I compare?

Compare at least three written quotes. This usually reveals whether one quote is an outlier and gives you a realistic local price range.

What is the best price for roller shutters?

The best price is the lowest complete like-for-like quote for a suitable product, not necessarily the lowest advertised number. A quote that excludes installation or electrical work is not directly comparable with an installed quote.

Can I upload a roller shutter quote to compare offers?

Yes. Upload your existing written quote through the free quote comparison service and approved local suppliers may submit a comparable offer. Availability, equivalence and savings are not guaranteed.
