Roller Shutter Prices by Window Size

Roller shutter pricing scales with window size because larger shutters need wider slats, stronger guides and end-retainers, and bigger motors if electric. Here's how price tracks against the most common Australian window sizes.

QUICK ANSWER

Roller shutter prices scale with window size, typically **\$400 for a small manual** shutter up to **\$2,750+ for a large motorised sliding door** shutter. Below is what each common window size usually costs across Australia.

Bottom line: Per-window price drops sharply when you bundle multiple windows on one install visit.

Who this is for: Homeowners measuring up windows before requesting roller shutter quotes.

Typical price ranges

Indicative supplied-and-installed pricing across Australia in 2026. Final pricing depends on installer assessment.

What changes the price

Slat width changes with span

Standard residential slats are ~37 mm. Beyond about 2.7 m wide, installers move to 55 mm or 75 mm slats which are stronger but more expensive.

Motor sizing

Larger shutters need higher-torque motors. A small standard motor might be \$80; a heavy-duty motor on a sliding-door shutter might be \$200+.

Box (headbox) size

Bigger shutters need bigger boxes to roll up inside. The box adds to the visible height and installer labour.

Two-person installs

Above about 1800 mm wide, most installers send two people. Labour cost roughly doubles for that window.

Bundling makes the per-window price drop

Most installers price aggressively for whole-of-house jobs because the labour overhead per visit drops as window count goes up. A single small window quoted on its own can be 30-50% more per unit than the same window inside an 8-10 window bundle. If you're renovating, do the whole house in one go.

Non-standard sizes need real measurements

Quotes for windows outside the standard sizes should always be confirmed after a physical site measure. Beware online estimates for double-height, arched, or angled windows. They're indicative only.

Checklist before you accept a quote



Measure the rough opening

Width and height of the actual hole in the wall, not the visible glass.



Note headbox space

Check there's enough clearance above the window for the shutter to roll into.



Confirm slat profile for the size

Ask the installer to specify slat width and material for each window.

**Get same-spec quotes**

For comparable quotes, ask each installer to quote the same slat profile.

Frequently asked questions

How much does a roller shutter cost for a standard window?

A standard 1500 × 1500 mm window typically costs \$600-\$1,000 for a manual shutter or \$1,000-\$1,550 for an electric shutter, supplied and installed.

How much for a roller shutter on a sliding door?

Sliding door shutters (around 2400 × 2100 mm) typically range from \$1,350-\$2,000 manual or \$1,800-\$2,750+ electric. Larger doors need heavy-duty slats and motors.

Do I save money buying many shutters at once?

Yes. Bundling 8-12 windows on one install visit typically reduces per-window pricing by 15-25% versus single-window purchases.
